

## SUMMER IS BACK - SO IS AQUATIC VEGETATION IN LAKE GASTON!

Summer has returned with all the many benefits, such as enjoying the lake we are lucky to have in our community. As we are boating, swimming, fishing, and paddling on the lake, all of us are reminded of the aquatic vegetation present in the

lake. Many of us appreciate the native vegetation that is so important to water quality, fisheries, wildlife habitat, and the aesthetics of the lake. Other folks "tolerate" the native vegetation, such as watershield, white water lily, arrowhead, american lotus, water willow, spadderdock, and other plants found on Lake Gaston.

Lake Gaston is a manmade lake that has mildly eutrophic conditions, meaning there are nutrients available, and in the heat of the summer, dissolved oxygen levels can be relatively low in some locations, especially in the shallow areas of the lake (including shorelines). This means Lake Gaston is going to have aquatic vegetation in many locations, again, primarily along the shorelines. I like to remind folks it's much better to have native vegetation in the lake than it is to have invasive and/or noxious plants/algae.

Most of us are familiar with the undesirable vegetation and algae found in Lake Gaston, specifically our "arch enemies" invasive hydrilla and noxious lyngbya. Without going into details here, let's just agree no one wants either of these in the lake, and especially around the shoreline near our docks or swimming areas. The information collected via these submittals is used, along with the annual LKG Vegetation Survey, to help determine where future vegetation/algae treatments may be conducted by the LGWCC.

The LGA works closely with the Lake Gaston Weed Control Council (LGWCC) and the NCSU Extension to manage aquatic vegetation on the lake. This is challenging work conducted primarily by LGA and LGWCC volunteers. If you live on or around Lake Gaston and have some spare time, please consider becoming a volunteer. You don't have to be an expert or even very knowledgeable on aquatic vegetation — you just need to have a desire to help maintain and improve the quality of the environment in the Lake Gaston community. #### **Be Prepared for Hurricane Season**



The Atlantic Hurricane season officially began on June 1, 2025, and will end on November 30, 2024. The mid-Atlantic season sees the most hurricanes in August, September, and October. All areas of our state, from the coast to the mountains, have been affected by hurricanes. NOAA's outlook for the 2025 Atlantic hurricane season is a 30% chance of a near-normal season, a 60% chance of an above-normal season, and a 10% chance of a below-normal season. The agency is forecasting 3 - 19 named storms, including 6 - 10 hurricanes, and 3 - 5 major hurricanes.

With this expected to be above normal hurricane season, now is the time to review your preparedness status in case we are impacted.

Some good steps include:

- Review your insurance policy.
- Assemble an emergency kit stocked with the right items, such as medications, extra eyeglasses, etc.
- Ensure everyone in your household knows and understands your hurricane plan.
  - Don't forget to include your pets.
  - o Know where you will go if you must evacuate and leave early.
- Know how to turn off the gas and electricity utilities to your home.
- Reduce outdoor hazards by removing or securing outdoor items around your home.
